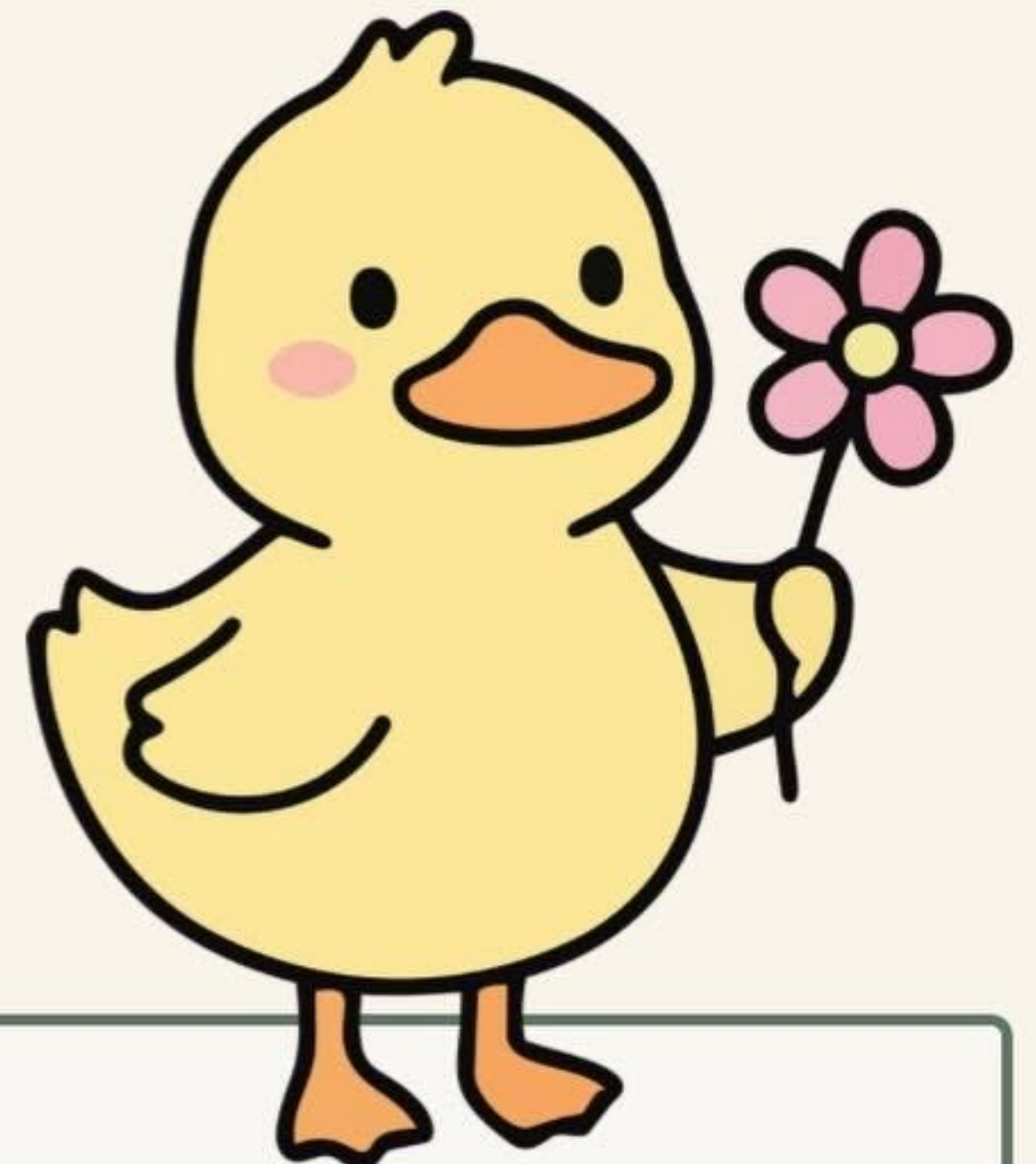
Wildcat Community Spotlight:
